

Graduate Research Assistantships in Insect Genomics and Evolution

The lab of Beryl Jones at the University of Kentucky (Department of Entomology) is recruiting graduate students for the Fall 2023 semester. Students will be part of a growing research group (lab grand opening July 2023) focused on the genomic and environmental factors shaping social plasticity in bees.

Student projects will include the investigation of gene regulatory changes associated with evolutionary transitions in bee sociality, leveraging the amazing and naturally occurring diversity of social behaviors across bee lineages. Projects will incorporate field, genomic, and computational methods for an organismal and integrative approach to understanding the mechanisms and consequences of phenotypic plasticity, with a special emphasis on social traits and using bees as a model system.

Applicants may come from a variety of backgrounds, including those with experience in biology, entomology, or a related field, and we are particularly interested in those with a strong interest in genomics and evolution. Financial support will be provided through research assistantships.
